


Oak Ridge Area Map

Route from Knoxville's McGhee Tyson Airport to Oak Ridge

- From the terminal at McGhee Tyson Airport, follow the signs to Route 129 North (to Knoxville). In approximately 2.5 miles, exit right onto I-140 W, Pellissippi Parkway (sign reads "To Oak Ridge").
- After approximately 12 miles, the road will merge into one lane and become Route 162 (still the Pellissippi Parkway). Continue on Route 162.
- After a few miles, the road will merge with Route 62. Pass through the town of Solway, and then you will cross a bridge over the Clinch River.
- To go to ORAU: Continue to go straight to Oak Ridge (do not take the Bethel Valley Exit). Once in Oak Ridge, pass straight through several red lights (the first is at the intersection of Illinois and Scarboro Roads). (Jump to number 5)
 - To go to the Scarboro Road building, UNIRIB, or Oak Ridge National Laboratory (X-10): Take the Bethel Valley Exit to the right. To reach the Scarboro Road building, turn left at the first traffic light. To reach ORNL and UNIRIB, go straight through the light and follow the signs (approximately 10 miles).
- On Illinois Avenue, turn right at the DoubleTree Hotel onto Badger Avenue. Take your first left after the ORAU sign into the parking lot. This is the entrance to the ORAU main campus.

Route from Knoxville's McGhee Tyson Airport to Oak Ridge

1. From the terminal at McGhee Tyson Airport, follow the signs to Route 129 North (to Knoxville). Continue approximately 2.5 miles, exit right onto I-140 W, Pellissippi Parkway (sign says "To Oak Ridge").
2. After approximately 12 miles, the road will merge into one lane and become Route 162 (still the Pellissippi Parkway). Continue on Route 162.
3. After a few miles, the road will merge with Route 62. Pass through the town of Solway, and then you will cross a bridge over the Clinch River.
4. a. To go to ORAU: Continue to go straight to Oak Ridge (do not take the Bethel Valley Exit). Pellissippi Parkway becomes Illinois Avenue. Once in Oak Ridge, pass straight through several red lights (the first is at the intersection of Illinois Avenue and Scarboro Road). (Jump to number 5)
b. To go to the Scarboro Road building, UNIRIB, or Oak Ridge National Laboratory (X-10): Take the Bethel Valley Exit to the right. To reach the Scarboro Road building, turn left at the first traffic light. The building is on the left. To reach ORNL and UNIRIB, continue straight through the light and follow the signs (approximately 10 miles).
5. On Illinois Avenue, turn right at the Doubletree Hotel onto Badger Avenue. On the left is the ORAU sign. Take the first left after the sign to enter the ORAU main campus parking lot.
6. To reach the Pollard Technology Conference Center and the ORISE new office building, continue straight through the parking lot and turn right at the end. The Pollard Center is on the left. The ORISE office building is immediately adjacent to the Pollard Center.
