1. **Prescreening using inventory tracking systems.** The Draft comparison of “Site-Specific Prescreening” (**AI 11-01**) identifies prescreening methods and limitations of the individual site’s prescreening process. Additional input was received and is currently being reviewed for incorporation. Upon incorporation, Courtney Haggard will submit a Final Draft to the CSWG membership for review and concurrence.
2. **PAC-30 Screening Overview.** Courtney Haggard reported that all comments received to date on the white paper “PAC-30 Screening Overview” (**AI 12-01**) have been addressed. A final version of this white paper will be submitted to NA-41 for approval and posted to the website.
3. **PAC-30 Screening Approaches.** Courtney Haggard discussed the project proposal for PAC-30 Screening Approaches (**AI 12-02**). A questionnaire will be developed as a guide for collecting PAC-30 Screening-related information from sites who use this approach.
4. **Global Harmonization System (GHS).** Mike Stanley asked if there has been any new information regarding the effects of GHS implementation. Dave Freshwater confirmed that there have been no new developments, and impacts of GHS on chemical screening are unlikely but are also still unknown. The group was referred to the 2012 EMI SIG presentation by Dina Siegel for more information regarding the impact of GHS implementation on other facets of Emergency Management and beyond.
