Roll Call

The STWG teleconference began five minutes later than its appointed time to allow members to participate in the national emergency alert signal test which was also scheduled at 2:00 p.m. EST. The test was conducted and lasted for a couple of minutes. Michele Wolfgram then conducted a roll call and noted that 11 working group members were participating in the teleconference.

Administrative Matters

Cliff Glantz stated that the call for proposals for presentations at the EMI-SIG and SCAPA meetings (May 14–17, 2012, in Seattle WA) has gone out. The deadline for submitting abstracts is moved forward this year to December 16, 2011. Cliff urged all to take note of this deadline and begin thinking about presentation topics.

Old Business

STWG-AI-09-03 (Activity Continuing): Respirable vs. Non-respirable Source Terms (Wayne Davis)

The final review draft of Wayne Davis' paper, *Respirable vs. Non-respirable Source Terms*, was sent out for STWG review on September 13, 2011; no comments were received over the past two months. STWG-AI-09-05 (Activity Continuing): Dose Equivalent Curies (Michele Wolfgram)

Michele is responsible for developing a draft position paper on the use of Dose Equivalent Curies and reported little action on this activity. She will make it a priority to move this forward and get it out for review before the next STWG conference call.

STWG-AI-11-01 (Activity Continuing): HotSpot Deposition Velocity

A project proposal developed about the HotSpot deposition velocity matter was discussed during the previous conference call when the group decided that this should be a joint activity conducted by the STWG, the SCAPA Consequence Assessment Modeling Working Group (CAMWG), and the Hazards Assessment Subcommittee (HASC). Several working group members volunteered to participate in working this activity. Michele brought the proposal to the HASC during their last conference call and obtained several volunteers to participate from that group as well. The SCAPA CAMWG, chaired by Jeremy Rishel, will be contacted in the near future to solicit their involvement in this joint activity. Afterwards, a teleconference of the group members will be scheduled. It was noted that a number of SCAPA members are already involved in a preliminary technical examination of this activity.
