The **Joint Science and Technology Institute for Middle School Students (JSTI-MS)** is a one-week, fully-funded, residential science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) challenge program that provides middle school students the opportunity to solve and complete STEM challenges and projects. The hands-on projects provide students with opportunities to develop problem-solving and collaboration skills. The purpose of the program is to provide students with an opportunity to solve STEM challenges while working as a member of a small team and to inspire them to become lifelong STEM learners.

Eligibility Criteria for Middle School Student Applicants:

- Must be a U.S. citizen
- Must be age 11 by July 1, 2018
- Must be entering the 6th, 7th, or 8th grade in the 2018-2019 academic year
- Must have a submitted reference to be considered. Reference requests are sent automatically from your application submission.
- Must be willing to follow all program and safety instructions
- Must be able to participate in all activities for the full-program period, July 29 - August 3, 2018
- Applications are accepted from students attending schools in the United States

NOTE

Current 8th graders who will be entering the 9th grade in 2018-2019 academic year are not eligible. Please apply next year in the spring of 2019 for the high school program.
